The Process - Spring 2023

- Chapters will submit the Fraternal Excellence in early April.
- FSL will score the packets and add FSL Engagement bonuses/deductions (see packet).
- Chapters earning a score of 100 or higher will earn the Chapter of Excellence designation.
- Chapters of Excellence will be recognized on the website, via social media, at the Leadership Awards Banquet, and in a plaque on campus.

The Process Moving Forward

- Chapters will submit the Fraternal Excellence packet twice each year – early December and early April.
- The December packet will cover Apr-Nov, the April packet will cover Dec-Mar.
- Point values may change to account for the full year and two submissions.
