- Update officers as soon as their term begins
- Remove any graduates or others not active for the spring and be sure to note their membership end date.

# Policy Feedback Session

- Events – Only off-campus events with specific features (alcohol)
- Events – Separate procedures for events outside of the "party" format
- Developmental Programs – required chapter-level programs focusing on relevant topics (sexual assault, substance use, mental health, etc.)
- FSL Ambassadors – Designated team of FSL members for tabling, events, etc.
- New Member Institute – values, expectations, community-building, risk management, etc.

# Fraternal Excellence (Standards)

- Chapters will submit a packet in early April
- The packet will describe the chapter's efforts related to
  - Chapter Operations
  - Member Development
  - Leadership
  - Service and Philanthropy
  - Risk Management
  - Campus Engagement

# Fraternal Excellence (Standards)

- Packets will be reviewed and scored
- Chapters performing at a high level in each category will be recognized
- Packet scores will be combined with an FSL Engagement score assigned by our office
- Chapters with high scores will be named "Chapters of Excellence"

# Fraternal Excellence (Standards)

- The goal is to recognize quality, not to create competition
- Chapters that fail to submit the packet in earnest, or whose engagement does not meet the minimum standard set in the packet, will face sanctions or other requirements

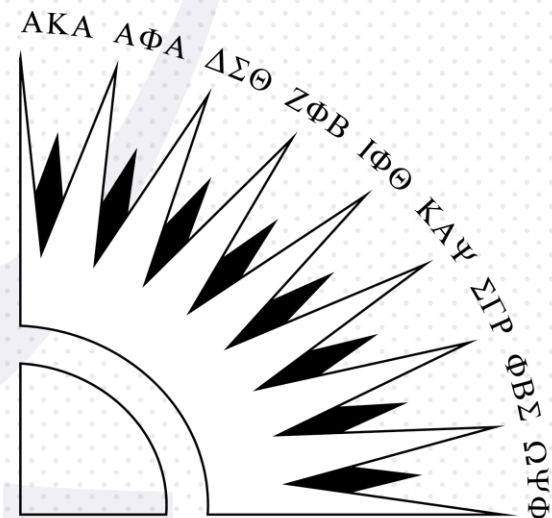
