

SB-F22-C001

An Act to Merge the SGA Constitution and By-Laws

Whereas, the governing documents of SGA have missing content from each other, and,

Whereas, to simplify for both representatives and students on campus we should merge both documents while keeping all content of substance that informs us on the SGA's operation, and,

Whereas, this has been done by taking any content or statements of guidance from the By-Laws and inserting them in a logical way into the Constitution, and,

Whereas, the Draft of this new Constitution is provided alongside this document for your evaluation and include highlights of all changes with comments on why or where in the By-Laws the content originated from, and,

Whereas, there is no significant difference between the amending procedures outlined in the Constitution verse those outlined in the By-Laws.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT

Section 1: This bill shall be known as the "SGA Governing Documents Merge Act of 2022".

Section 2: All changes and inserts of content from the By-Laws will be adopted into the Constitution.

Section 3: This bill shall take effect the following semester upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.
