**An Act to Commission the SGA Constitutional Reform Committee to Review the Grammar and Formatting of the SGA By-laws**

- Whereas,** the SGA By-laws provide further definition to the provisions found in the Constitution of the Student Government Association, and,
- Whereas,** the current By-laws have many grammar and formatting issues, and,
- Whereas,** these issues cause the By-laws to be hard to read and comprehend, and,
- Whereas,** it is important for each Senator to read and understand the provisions found in By-laws, and,
- Whereas,** fixing the grammar and formatting issues will help aid Senators in understanding how the Student Government Association operates and conducts business.

**NOW THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT**

- Section 1: This bill shall be known as the “SGA By-laws Recompilation Act of 2022”.
- Section 2: The Constitutional Reform Committee of the SGA Senate will review and revise the grammar and formatting of the SGA By-laws.
- Section 3: The Constitutional Reform Committee of the SGA Senate will submit the revised By-laws to the Senate no later than March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022
- Section 4: This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.


