## Nursing Administration Online MSN

Our MSN Nursing Administration program is a 36 credit-hour degree that covers the financial, human resource, and quality assurance course content needed to be an effective nurse-manager. ### A dmission Requirements

- An unencumbered license to practice as a Registered Nurse in Tennessee or in the state in which your clinical assignments will be completed.
- A Bachelor's degree in Nursing with an overall GPA of 3.0. Provisional admission for students with below a 3.0 may be considered only on a case-by-case basis.
- Completion of or planned enrollment in a statistics course.
- Please note that the Nursing Administration concentration admits for Fall semesters only.

## Required Documents:

- ◆ Copy of your RN licensure
- ◆ State-issued ID
- ◆ A brief letter of intent/cover letter discussing your interest in the program
- ◆ Resume or CV
- ◆ Transcripts for any previously attended schools
- ◆ Three letters of reference or contact information for three references
  - ◆ At least one professional reference
  - ◆ At least one educational reference
  - ◆ Apply for Fall admission by July 1st. The Nursing Administration program admits only in the Fall semesters.
