



Post-Graduate Nursing Education Certification

The Nursing Education Post-Graduate Certificate is a fully-online certificate program that includes the coursework needed to work as a Nurse Educator. Course loads are flexible and most students complete the certificate in 4 semesters with 2 courses per semester. Courses are taught completely by our graduate nursing faculty and clinical and education hour requirements are completed with preceptors local to your area.

A dmission Requirements

-An unencumbered license to practice as a Registered Nurse in Tennessee or in the state in which your clinical assignments will be completed.

-A Master's degree in Nursing with an overall GPA of 3.0. Provisional admission for students with below a 3.0 may be considered only on a case-by-case basis.

 - ◆ At least one professional reference
 - ◆ At least one educational reference
 - ◆ Apply for Fall admission by July 1st and for Spring admission by November 1st.
