- If loss of income other than wages, include a detailed explanation of the income included on the FAFSA that is no longer received (Ex. child support, alimony, etc.), and when, why and the amount that is no longer being received.

2. The death of a parent or spouse in calendar year 2021, 2022 or after.

- A copy of the death certificate or obituary including the student's name and relationship... and
- A SIGNED copy of their 2021 Tax Return with schedules and copies of all W2 forms, 1099s, etc., *or a complete 2021 Tax Return Transcript from the IRS ...AND... a SIGNED copy of their 2022 tax return information IF the death occurred after calendar year 2021.*
- **And... if requested**, download from Eagle Online, complete and sign the 2023-2024 Verification Worksheet, based on the student's dependency status on the FAFSA.
