Effective September 1, 2019, the Tennessee Department of Education is no longer accepting the Praxis II Elementary Education Content Knowledge exam (code: 5018). The new assessment(s) and qualifying scores are as follows:

For ELED Majors K-5 only:

• Elementary Education Multiple Subjects (5001) – Note: this exam/code contains all 4 subtests

Reading & Language Arts Subtest (5002) – Passing Score: 157

Mathematics Subtest (5003 – Passing Score: 157

Social Studies Subtest (5004) – Passing Score: 155

• Science Subtest (5005) – Passing Score: 159



*** IF YOU TOOK AND PASSED THE 5018 BEORE THE PRAXIS TEST CHANGED— YOU DO NOT HAVE TO TAKE THE 5001. THIS IS WITHIN FIVE YEARS FROM THE TEST DATE. **

IMPORTANT: Prospective Teacher Candidates

The codes for Praxis CORE exams are changing to the following: CORE math (5733), CORE reading (5713), and CORE writing (5723). Passing scores will be accepted for both current and new exams through August 31, 2020: CORE math (5732 and 5733), CORE reading (5712 and 5713), and CORE writing (5722 and 5723). Passing scores for these exams will not change.


