GUIDELINES FOR AWARD OF UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

CRITERIA:

1. Scholarships will be awarded by the College of Business Board of Trustees to full-time undergraduate students (enrolled for 12 or more hours).
2. The applicant should have a high school average of "B" or higher, a community college point average of 3.5 or higher from an accredited high school or community college, or a TTU QPA of 3.2 through at least 60 semesters hours, with an acceptable ACT score.
3. The applicants should have demonstrated leadership ability as a student or through other active involvement with groups, organizations, etc.
4. There should be a clear objective toward a career in business and business-related professions.
5. Financial need will only be a factor in deciding between otherwise equal candidates.
6. Applications are to be reviewed by a scholarship committee and winners must respond in writing to the College of Business Board of Trustees.
7. Awards will be made directly to the Financial Aid Office to be credited toward the maintenance fee of the recipients.
8. In the event that no qualified applications are received, no awards will be made.
