



First-Year Tracking of First-Time Freshmen of Fall 2008:

Agricultural and Human Sciences

This report contains information about first-time freshmen of Fall 2008 in the College of Agricultural and Human Sciences and their status in Fall 2009. Student tracking information is presented for each program of study in which first-time freshmen of Fall 2008 were enrolled.

Tables are grouped by students' Fall 2008 programs and information is displayed about the student status in Fall 2009. Of the students originally enrolled in a given program in Fall 2008, the status one year later can indicate one of three conditions:

- a. Enrolled in original program
- b. Enrolled in different program
- c. Not enrolled at the University

The "Frequency Missing" value indicates the number of students who were not enrolled at the University in Fall 2009.
