



## Getting Started With ResNet

(v1.2)

Welcome to Resnet at TTU. To help you get started, we have provided a few tips below. Much more information is available at our web site:

As a student, you have access to several services through the use of your account, including:

- Student Email (*typically referred to as your Live@Edu account*)
- Internet Access in the Dorms and Tech Village
- PC Lab Access

### Connecting Your PC to the Network

1. Start by connecting your Ethernet cable to you PC and the outlet in your room.
2. Launch a web browser and go to <http://resnet.tntech.edu>. You will see a page similar to the one shown below.
3. Make sure you review the campus computing policies by visiting the web site listed above. You will be held accountable for these policies.
4. You will need to know your campus username. Click on “Find your username” for assistance or login to Eagle Online and under Personal Information and it is the first portion of your email address before the ‘@’ symbol.
5. Once you know your campus username, click on “Change your PC Lab password.” Type in your T Number as your Old Password.

(i.e. If your T Number is T00012345, you would type T00012345, making sure the T is capital.) Now you are required to set a new password. Choose a password of 6-15 characters *that you can easily remember*, using letters and digits. Nor spaces or special characters (i.e. @#\$%^) are allowed. Also, you cannot use common words found in the system’s dictionary. You may wish to use the first letters of a phrase with some numbers, such as “I am here to learn until 2010.” which would make your password: iahtlu2010.

6. Return to <http://resnet.tntech.edu>. Type in your username and password. You may wish to have Resnet remember your username by clicking the box beside *Remember my Username*. Click Login.
7. You should now see a confirmation screen telling you that you have successfully connected to Resnet.

For security reasons, logins will **expire** periodically and you will need to log into Resnet again. We suggest that you make <http://resnet.tntech.edu> your home page, or create a bookmark or link for it so that you can access it easily.

## University Labs

---

In over thirty University computer labs across campus, your PCLab account will also give you access to the campus network and permanent disk space on the network **U: Drive**. You can easily save your class work on the **U: Drive** so that you can come back to it and continue working on it from any lab location. ## Email

Each registered student has an email account on the Inbox server. Your email address is ***yourusername@students.tntech.edu***. Your email username is the **same** as your Resnet & PC Lab username.
