

The follow instructions are for connecting the Tennessee Tech University's wireless networks configured in the residence halls for student use internet access. - 1) Click on the Airport icon in your menu bar



- 2) Click on **RESNET_WIFI**. Once connected your selected wireless access point should have a ✓ beside it.



- 3) After connecting open up your preferred internet browser (i.e. Safari, Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, and or Opera).

- 4) Navigate to resnet.tntech.edu

- 5) Login with your username and password
