HOW TO TRANSFER TO TENNESSEE TECH

We are pleased that you are considering transferring to Tennessee Technological University.

Tennessee Tech is a comprehensive university with six colleges and schools that offer undergraduate degrees in agriculture, business administration, education, engineering, human ecology, liberal and fine arts, the sciences, and nursing. Graduate degrees are also available in many areas at Tennessee Tech.

APPLYING TO TENNESSEE TECH IS EASY - HERE IS ALL YOU NEED TO DO.

1. Obtain an admission form from the Office of Admissions, Box 5006, Tennessee Technological University, Cookeville, TN 38505. Be sure to include a nonrefundable \$15 application fee. Apply as soon as possible prior to the beginning of the semester you wish to enter.
2. Ask each technical school, college, or university you have attended to send your transcripts to the Office of Admissions. If you are currently taking classes, have your school send a partial transcript now and a completed one at the end of the term.
3. The official grade point average will be computed on hours and grades earned at your previous college or university. Credit is transferred with the grade made in the course. For example, an "A" is transferred as an "A" and an "F" is transferred as an "F".
4. If you want to live in a dormitory or married student apartment, obtain a housing application from the Office of Residential Life, Box 5016, Tennessee Technological University, Cookeville, TN 38505.

As soon as your application and transcripts have been received and evaluated, you will be notified about your admission status. Tentative admission may be granted on the basis of partial transcripts if your prior academic work is clearly acceptable. Final admission is granted only after all your credentials have been evaluated. You will be sent a Certificate of Admission when you have been accepted.
