

Collecting Instant Feedback

One of the newer instruments in the IDEA suite is a very short, formative assessment that faculty can use as many times as they wish throughout a course. The **IDEA Instant Feedback Form** is designed to collect feedback from students "in the moment." It can be used after a class session or periodically throughout a term as a way to gauge student engagement and learning. - To launch the Instant Feedback Form, go to your Faculty Dashboard, select a course, and open Data Tools in the upper right-hand corner.
- Send your students the link for feedback and watch your results come in!
