Rules of Conduct

Your minor child is participating in a non-credit course at Tennessee Tech University. Please read the rules of conduct that are part of TTU's minors on campus policy:

- Your child's name, your emergency contact information and the location of your child while on campus has been given to University Police.
- In the case of an emergency including medical or behavioral problems, natural disaster or other significant program disruptions In case of emergency, TTU will call the person designated as the primary contact at the number provided
- In the case of an emergency, you may contact your child by calling University Police 931-372-3234.
- You are required to disclose any physical, mental or medical condition the minor may have that could impact his/her participation in the above named program.
- Personal "epi pens" and inhalers may be carried by the participant during activities.
- If an issue arises where the participant misses class due to an emergency, illness or injury refunds will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- The possession or use of alcohol and other drugs, fireworks, guns and other weapons are prohibited on Tennessee Tech University Campus.
- The parking of staff and participant vehicles must be in accordance with TTU parking regulations. Participants should display their parking pass and may park in any designated parking spot not marked "handicapped" or "30-minute" parking. - No violence, including sexual abuse or harassment, will be tolerated.
- Hazing of any kind is prohibited. Bullying including verbal, physical and cyber bullying are prohibited.
- No theft of property regardless of owner will be tolerated.
- No use of tobacco products will be tolerated.
- Misuse or damage of TTU property is prohibited. Charges will be assessed against those participants who are responsible for damage or misuse of TTU property.
- The inappropriate use of cameras, imaging and digital devices is prohibited including use of such devices in showers, restrooms or other areas where privacy is expected by participants.
