

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS



Applicants must have an undergraduate degree in business with a major in Accounting (or the equivalent) from an accredited school or university, or be in their final semester of undergraduate coursework. Accounting major equivalency can be achieved by presenting evidence of successful completion of two courses in Intermediate Financial Accounting and one course each in Cost Accounting, Taxation, and Auditing.

While it is not required, it is helpful if students have successfully completed at least one undergraduate course in business or accounting analytics.

TO APPLY, YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING:

- ✓ **A current resume.** Make sure your resume contains dates for all work experience and degrees received.
- ✓ **Official transcripts** from all institutions where you took classes or received a degree. You may provide copies of transcripts to speed the application process, but official transcripts will be needed to finalize admission.

FACTORS THAT MAY BE CONSIDERED IN THE ADMISSION DECISION ARE:

- ✓ Undergraduate GPA*
- ✓ Professional or Accounting Work Experience or Internships
- ✓ Other Graduate Degrees and Relevant Achievements
- ✓ Significant leadership roles

* Although not required, we strongly recommend that you consider preparing for and taking the GMAT (preferred) or GRE if your undergraduate GPA is below 3.0 and/or you, have little or no professional work experience, as the results may weigh favorably on the admission decision. 
