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

1. Refer to Sheet C1 on Plans: Contractor shall include in Base Bid the removal and replacement of five crab orchard stone tiles near main entrance. Tiles are approximately 18"x18"x2".
2. Refer to Sheets A1 and A2 on Plans: Elevations show shelf angles running below limestone panels. Limestone panels are not to be removed. New through-wall flashing shall terminate at all brick-to-limestone junctures with an end dam.
3. See attached Clarifications.
4. Contractor shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum on Bid Form.

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CLARIFICATIONS
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Q: Is the AIA-310 bid bond ok?

A: Yes, this is acceptable.

Q: I don't see what we are doing with the dust collector. I read this as the duct and supports are to be removed from the roof. Does the collector remain or should we be figuring removal?

A: It all is to be removed at least below the roof deck.

Q: In the asbestos abatement specifications 3.04A, it states that the abatement contractor must employ a 3rd party certified air monitor to perform down wind air sampling during all abatement activities. Will this be removed in an addendum? This is very unusual for asbestos roofing and very costly.

A: The consultant recommended we leave this requirement in the Specifications to protect the Owner.
