The Washington Center Internship Program is now available to students at Tennessee Technological University. Applications are being accepted for the **Summer2020** session only. The deadline for application is March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Interested students should send a one page letter of intent (stating how the internship would impact your future career goals) and a resume to:

Students must meet the following eligibility requirements:

**Be at least 18 years old**  
**Be a sophomore or above and have completed at least two semesters at Tech by the start of the program May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020**  
**Maintain a GPA of at least 2.75 / 4.0**

This is an excellent, world class opportunity for the right TTU student. Tennessee Technological University has been awarded grant funding to sponsor students who are selected for the program. Although open to all majors the program is particularly suited for students interested in careers in law, public service, city, county, state or federal government careers, or for those interested in politics. Internship areas include: Arts, Humanities, Education, Business, Health and Sciences, Journalism, Media and Communications, Criminal Justice and/or International Relations.

Please read over the attached documents carefully as they highlight the nuances of the program very well. You can also view numerous videos on TWC Intern program by going to YouTube.com and searching "The Washington Center Intern Program".

Although Tennessee Tech has been awarded grant funding to help Tech students offset the cost of the program, students interested in interning should understand that out-of-pocket costs for the program are approximately \$5,000 - \$8,000 per student to participate.
