- **Assignment Tool**
 - The Assignment tool in iLearn allows faculty to create assessments with instructions and files (if needed) where students can submit the completed files. It also has a grading area where faculty can annotate on the submitted document, as well as attach other files for feedback or even leave video and audio notes to the students. Once graded, if the assignment is linked to an associated grade in the Grades area, the grade will automatically be recorded there too with the appropriate feedback.
