Accessible Documents


- Chances are you have a lot of content you have already created. These documents can be uploaded into the Content Tool in iLearn or other locations like WordPress.
- SensusAccess Need to make a document accessible? You can upload a document to this site and get an accessible version (for most documents) emailed to you. This does not include documents with a lot of graphical equations.

Videos

There are several options for how to add video content to your course: Kaltura, Video Note, PowerPoint with Voicceover, or Doceri. Information for each option can be found below.

Kaltura

- Downloading Kaltura Capture
 - Login to download Kaltura Capture
 - o For *iLearn*, go to **Tech Express** or **ilearn.tntech.edu**
 - o For *MediaSpace*, go to <u>media.tntech.edu</u>
 - Once logged in, for iLearn, select My Media in the navigation (or go to a course and choose Media - My Media)
 - Select the **Add New** button (iLearn) or link (Mediaspace)



- Choose Kaltura Capture
- To Download,


o For Windows (or personal Macs), select the download link



- For Macs (on TTU machines), go to Self Service and download Capture from there.

- Uploading a video file made outside Kaltura Capture and link to Content in iLearn


Video Note

- The internal Video Note option in iLearn (D2L) allows for recording up to 30 minutes. This is a quick and easy way to add Announcements and short bits of information in the course.
 - To add it to the Announcements, go to the course and select New Announcement in the arrow to the right of Announcements.




Enter a Headline


Select the Insert Stuff button




 Choose Video Note (TIP: You can also link to YouTube videos using the Insert Stuff button in Announcements, Content, Discussions and anywhere you see this HTML editor.)



 Make sure your camera and microphone settings are correct and Allow access to the program.



Select New Recording to start your recording.
NOTE: The recording time has been increased to 10 minutes.



• Select **Stop Recording** when you are done.



- Click Next
- Give the recording a **Title** and **Description**
- Choose Audio Language, English and check the Automatically generate captions from audio option.
- Click **Next**
- If you are happy with your recording, click Insert
- Finish the settings for the Announcement and Publish
