

TechExpress Attendance - Student

This document outlines the steps for students to register attendance using TechExpress.

Check-In

Students can check in to class by scanning the QR code provided by the instructor, or by logging in to TechExpress and entering the **Attendance Key** provided below the QR Code.

Option 1: QR Code

Students will need to register their devices to use the QR Code function. This is automatically accomplished if the student has visited Express from their device outside of a private browsing window. If a student has not previously done this, they will be prompted to get registered the first time they scan the QR code for attendance.

- 1. Display the QR Code for students to scan on their mobile devices.
- 2. Have students scan the QR Code using their phone's camera and follow the link.
- 3. If the student's device is not registered they will be prompted to do so, as seen below. NOTE: Registration of the device will only have to be completed once.




4. Once the device has been registered, the student will scan the QR Code again and receive a notification that their attendance has been recorded.

NOTE: A student will not be able to record their attendance using the QR Code if their device is using a private browsing experience. This is typically characterized by the student being unable to get past the get registered screen.


Option 2: Attendance Key

Students can follow the steps below to record their attendance if they do not have a mobile device with a QR code scanner. The **Attendance Key** is located below the QR Code (See example in Step 6 below).


- 1. Log in to TechExpress on a laptop or mobile device
- 2. Scroll to the Student Life section card in TechExpress




3. Find the correct class from the courses listed under the Class Schedule.



4. Select the Check-In button.



5. Students will be prompted to enter the **Attendance Key**.



6. The **Attendance Key** is below the QR code.
