SMALL GROUP INSTRUCTIONAL DIAGNOSTIC

Book a Small Group Instructional Diagnostic for your course today!

Small Group Instructional Diagnostic (SGID) is a simple and straightforward evaluation process that uses structured small group discussions among students in a class to provide confidential feedback to an instructor, generally around the midpoint of a term. This semester, the **CITL will be conducting SGIDs from March 21-28th.**

A facilitator from the CITL will guide your students through a series of questions about the course, individually and in small groups, where the small group members must reach a consensus on their answers. Then, in a large group process, each small group answers each question, with the class voting “agree,” “disagree,” or “neutral” to each statement. A feedback report from the process is presented to the instructor within 48 hours.
