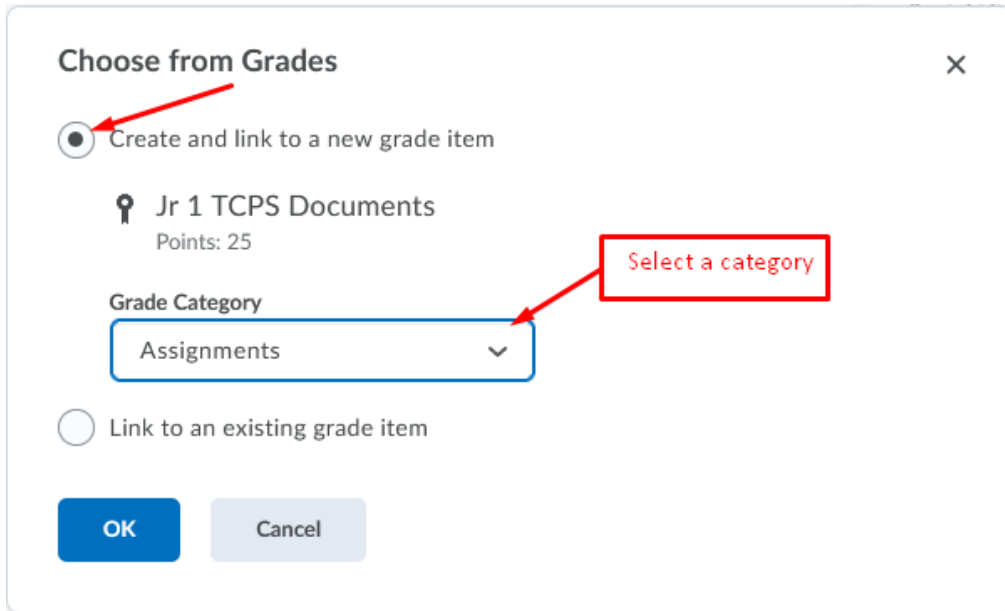
When you add a score for the assignment, you can choose to Create and Link to a new grade item or you can choose to Link to an existing grade item.

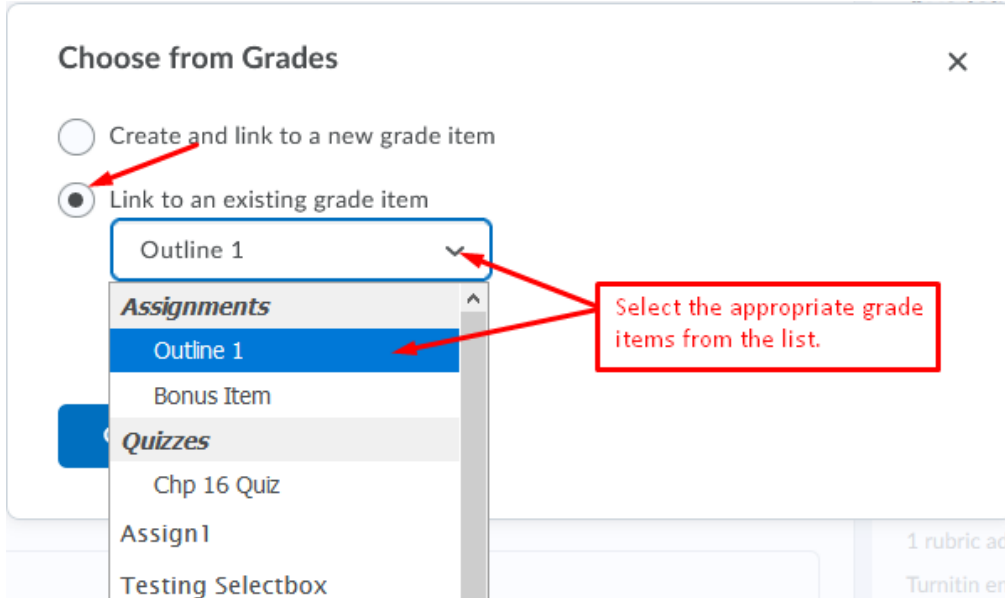

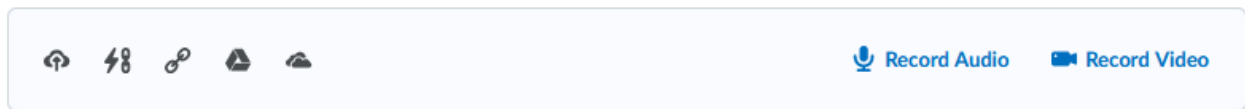


When you select to Create a new grade item, make sure to choose the appropriate Category. You may also want to go back to the Grades are and update the Short Names if you have a lot of grades. You can do this by going to Grades - Manage Grades, select the top checkbox for Bulk Edit and edit the Short Names for the created Grade items.

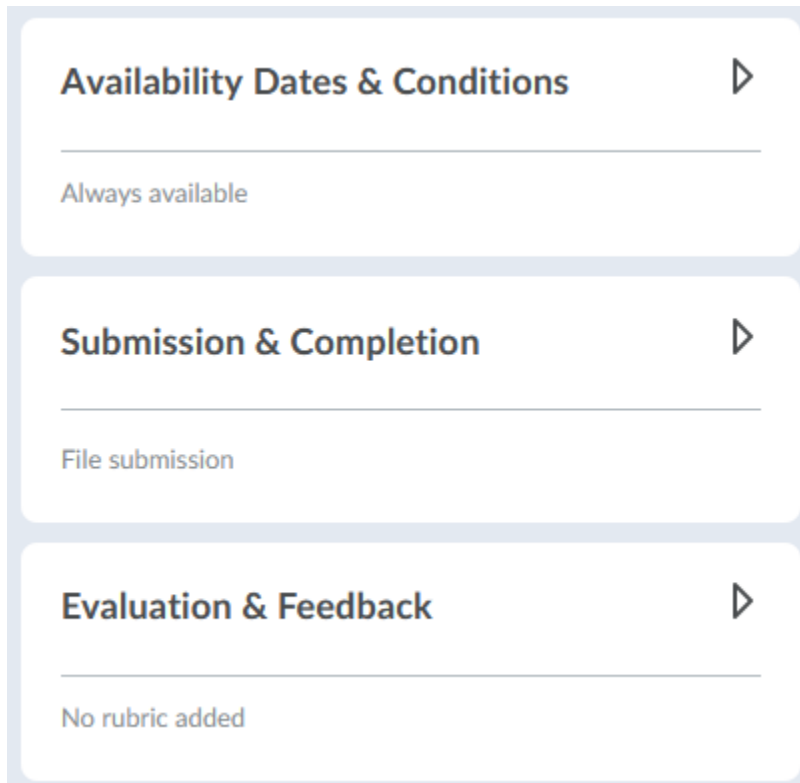


As before, if you already have your Grades setup, you can continue to link to the existing grade item by selecting it from the Dropdown list.
