

Budget Advisory Committee

Charge to the Committee:

The Budget Advisory Committee is an advisory body to the President. The committee will proactively serve to advise the President at his/her discretion on major long-and-short-term budgetary matters. The committee also reviews and provides input into the budgeting processes as appropriate. The committee will facilitate communication of the University's operating budget that is transparent and informative.

Committee Membership:

The Vice President for Planning and Business shall serve as chair of the committee. The committee members shall include the below positions. Additional members may be appointed by the President.

- All Academic Deans
- President of Faculty Senate
- Immediate Past President of Faculty Senate
- Incoming President of Faculty Senate
- Two members of the faculty appointed by the President
- President of SGA
