Tennessee State Board of Education Educator Licensure Policy 5.502 states the following:

Provisional Special Education Endorsement. Licensed educators enrolled in an additional endorsement program may add a provisional special education endorsement by submitting a recommendation from an approved educator preparation provider verifying

- 1. Enrollment in a program of study for additional endorsement in the specialty area; and
- 2. An assurance that the candidate will be assigned a mentor who is appropriately endorsed in the area where the candidate is seeking additional endorsement.

In order to transition from a provisional endorsement to a full endorsement, educators must submit passing scores on required assessments and successfully complete the program of study within three (3) years of receiving a provisional endorsement. All provisional endorsements will become inactive three (3) years after issuance.

... if you want to add the endorsement while you continue teaching in your current licensure area:

- 1. Contact Amanda Roberts (aroberts@tntech.edu) and tell her you want to be part of the SPED add-on cohort.
- 2. Register and complete 5 courses.
- 3. Pass the respective Praxis licensure exam (at some point during coursework).
- 4. Tech will recommend you for the add-on endorsement in TN Compass at the end of your coursework.

... if your school/district wants you to begin teaching in a SPED position immediately:

1. Contact Amanda Roberts (aroberts@tntech.edu) and tell her you want to be part of the SPED add-on cohort.

Obtain an Intent to Hire letter from your school/district; submit to Tech's Office of Teacher Ed. The letter must include your name, school, add-on area, and names/license numbers of 1-2 teachers who will serve as mentors to you.
As soon as you register for and begin coursework, Tech will recommend you for the provisional SPED add-on endorsement in TN Compass.

4. Begin teaching in your desired SPED position as the teacher of record.

- 5. Complete all 5 courses.
- 6. Pass the respective Praxis licensure exam (at some point during coursework).

7. Tech will change your status in TN Compass as a completer of the add-on endorsement at the end of your coursework.
