One of several graduate degrees available through our Department of Curriculum & Instruction, the **fully-online Learning Design & Technology master's** is a new and timely option for professional advancement in a variety of fields.

"The program prepares professionals to design curriculum and/or content across education, government, and private corporations through design principles and technology skills," said Jeremy Wendt, chair of the department. "These applications are in high demand, ensuring robust career options."

While pursuing a graduate degree at Tech, all students have access to earn two (2) optional, non-degree certificates. The certificates are 12 credit hour programs with a defined set of four (4) core courses.



1) Computer Science Education Certificate

This is the first computer science education licensure option in Tennessee. The program allows pre-service and in-service teachers to receive license endorsements, while promoting and integrating computer science education in the K-12 environment.

2) Instructional Design Certificate

This program is designed to enhance current concentrations within Curriculum & Instruction. We have created new pathways for faculty, administrators, and students in this rapidly expanding field.
