CEHS Receives High Marks on National & State Accreditation Review

Our college has recently and successfully completed its national and state accreditation review by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) and Tennessee Department of Education (TDOE).

CAEP advances equity and excellence in educator preparation through evidence-based accreditation that assures quality and supports continuous improvement to strengthen P-12 student learning.

The CAEP and state review, occurring every seven (7) years, is an 18-month process starting with a Self-Study Report followed by feedback, site visits, council review, and national accreditation decision. The state-level review of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

encompasses an initial report from the college followed by feedback, a site visit, deliberations, and final decision.

“Our college’s accreditation process is lengthy and detailed,” said Dean Lisa Zagumny. “The depth of review is essential due to the breadth of our PreK-12 teacher education programs, from introductory experiences and practica outcomes to student disposition documentation. We are very pleased with our latest accreditation report and the positive reflection on our students, faculty, and programs.”
