Job-Embedded Candidates

What is Job-Embedded?

An opportunity for a school district to hire a qualified individual as the teacher-of-record. A Job-Embedded practitioner's license is valid for 3 years while completing an Educator Prep Program.

How does an individual qualify for a Job-Embedded License?

- 1. Hold a Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited university
- 2. Must show "proof of content knowledge." This can be through a Bachelor's degree with a major in the subject of your endorsement or have passed the content knowledge Praxis or NES for the area.
- 3. Be hired as the teacher of record by a school system in which TTU has a current partnership

What does TTU's Job-Embedded program entail?

Most Job-Embedded program concentrations require completion of a Master's or Ed.S. degree. These programs are approximately 36-42 hours of coursework. Some courses have an online option however, some courses would require coming to main campus (Cookeville, TN).

What are the steps to enroll in TTU's Job-Embedded licensure pathway?

Steps to Enroll

Admission to TTU: https://www.tntech.edu/graduatestudies/admissions.php

- 1. Contact the Office of Teacher Education
- 2. Complete admission to the University
- 3. District submits an Intent to Hire letter stating the individual is hired as the teacher of record
- 4. Request an official copy of transcripts and Praxis or NES scores (if applicable) sent to our licensure analyst, Dr. Amanda Roberts.
- 5. Complete a license application for the Office of Teacher Education

Program Completion

- 1. Successful completion of all coursework, Praxis or NES testing requirements, and program requirements.
- Successful completion of at least 100 days of teaching experience as the teacher of record. All teaching experience must be uploaded in TNCompass
- 3. Complete a second teaching license application.
