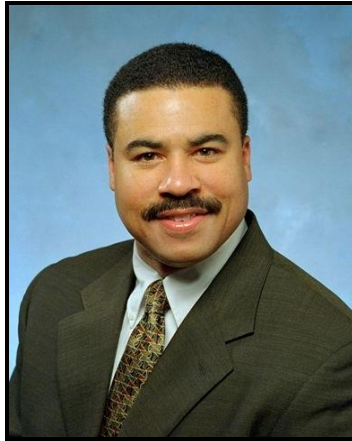

### Citation

Stanley N. Manning is Operations Director for the SC Johnson Company, Frimley Green UNITED KINGDOM and Lane Cove, AUSTRALIA. He is charged with the establishment and execution of the strategic direction for the Product supply organization. He manages all aspects related to facilities maintenance and all safety, health, and environmental concerns.

He earned the Bachelor of Arts at the University of Tennessee-Knoxville, with a major in chemistry in December of 1981; the Bachelor of Science in chemical engineering from Tennessee Technological University in June of 1984; and in May of 2000, he earned the Masters of Business Administration from Northwood University

In 1984, he joined The Dow Chemical Company-Walnut Creek in Pittsburg, California, where he performed various engineering assignments relative to manufacturing. In 1990, he was one of five individuals selected to serve the company in improving the division safety record. Soon, thereafter, he joined The Dow Chemical Company-Fresno, California (Ziploc), serving as Technical Assistance Superintendent. In that role he supervised capital and production engineering groups in implementing business goals.

In 1995, he joined The Dow Chemical Company/SC Johnson, Bay City, Michigan, serving as Technical Superintendent, Engineering and Maintenance. He supervised the production engineers, engineering design group, maintenance technicians, and information systems/process control group.

Moving to Michigan in 1996, he became the Superintendent, Produce Product Leader (Ziploc). In this capacity, he managed all plant functions including engineering, maintenance, operations, quality, and training. Of his accomplishments in this role, the company experienced improved plant asset utilization while lowering maintenance costs, high performance work teams being put in place, and sustained peak performance levels.

From 1999 until 2004, with the SC Johnson Company, he served as LMT Bldg 59 Plant Manager and Liquids Plant Manager in Racine, Wisconsin. He managed all plant functions along with the addition of planning and finance. During the period of time (2002-2004) spent in Racine, WI, he became the Worldwide Manufacturing Sourcing Manager-Home Storage/Auto Care.

From 2004-2007, he served the SC Johnson Company as Global Operations Support Manager, coordinating global supply chain cost improvement efforts within Product Supply. In January 2007, he became Operations Director, Frimley Green, UNITED KINGDOM and Lane Cove, AUSTRALIA.

In serving the TTU College of Engineering, Mr. Manning has been the catalyst that created the Minority Engineering Program (MEP) Endowment in 2007. This endowment is a testament to the dedication, loyalty, and love that Stanley Manning holds for his alma mater.
