Graduate Student Scholarship

CRITERIA

Any College of Engineering graduate, international student who meets the criteria outlined below will be eligible for this scholarship.

- Must be a current graduate student in good standing, having completed a minimum of nine (9) credit hours of graduate coursework, in accordance with current institutional policies.
- The candidate should be in possession of a valid student visa for the duration of the scholarship.
- Secondary preference should be given to students from Annamalai University, India, from which Dr. Deivanayagam graduated in 1963.

The minimum annual scholarship award will be \$1,500. An individual can receive this award one time only; this scholarship is not renewable.

Summer/Fall 2022 Entry Term

APPLICATION TIMELINE

Beginning August 1, 2021

- Apply for Admission to Tennessee Tech for the Fall 2022 term
- Apply for Scholarships (Students who submit their scholarship application by January 15th will have a greater chance of consideration for departmental scholarships.)

May 1, 2022

- Deadline to apply for scholarships
- Deadline to complete FAFSA for scholarship consideration

June 1, 2022

- Deadline to provide college transcripts
- Deadline for letters of recommendation to be submitted through ScholarWeb

Ongoing

- Scholarship awarding will take place on a rolling basis. The sooner you apply, the more likely you will be to receive certain scholarships.
- Check your Tennessee Tech email account frequently after you apply to ensure you accept any scholarship offers promptly.
