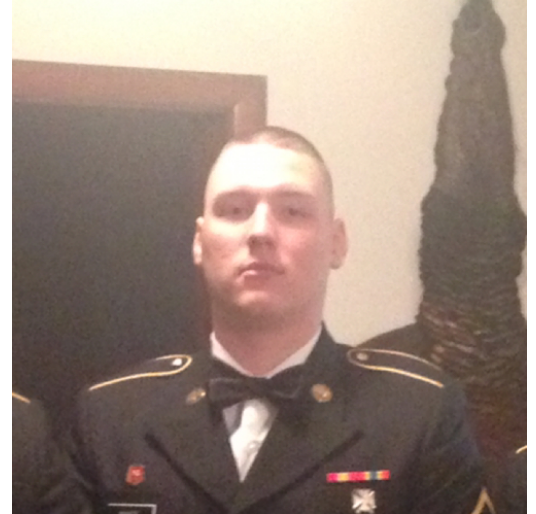

CoE Graduate Receives ROTC Commission

On December 12, Nicholas Stephen White was commissioned as a second lieutenant in the United States Army Reserves. White will serve in Ordnance, and will be assigned to the 278th Troop E, Special Troops Squadron Armored Cavalry, Regiment, Tennessee National Guard. White completed basic training and AIT at Fort Leonard Wood for combat engineering, and has also completed ROTC's Leadership Development Assessment Course.

White graduated in December with a bachelor of science degree in manufacturing and engineering technology; during his time at Tennessee Tech University, he served as an engineering intern at Shiroki North America.

TTU's Military Science department was established in 1950, and commissioned its first 11 officers the next year. Over the years, 1,670 officers have been commissioned from TTU, including eight who attained the rank of general.
