

## **Masters in Computer Science Checklist** (starting Fall 2012)

	Student presents "Thesis/Project Proposal" to Committee ( <i>thesis</i> : no later than before the beginning of TWO semesters before expected graduation; <i>project</i> : no later than beginning of semester before expected semester of graduation)
	Student finishes required coursework
	Student applies for Graduation
	Student requests date for Defense ( <i>thesis</i> : at least THREE weeks before Defense; <i>project</i> : at least TWO weeks before Defense)
	Student submits thesis/project report to Supervisory Committee ( <i>thesis</i> : at least TWO weeks before Defense; <i>project</i> : at least ONE week before Defense)
	Student participates in exit interview with Department Chair.
	Supervisory Committee conducts oral Defense by the candidate and reports results to Graduate School



 Student submits thesis to the Graduate School for first mechanical check ( <i>thesis only</i> ) (allow TWO weeks for this process)
 Student submits final approved and signed thesis to Graduate School (thesis only), or to Supervising Professor (project only) (at least ONE week before graduation)
 Student purchases at least TWO bound copies of thesis, (one for department library, one for supervising professor), and ONE electronic copy to the department ( <i>thesis only</i> )
 Student returns loaned books to Faculty, Department and Library
