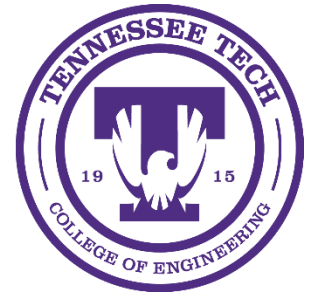

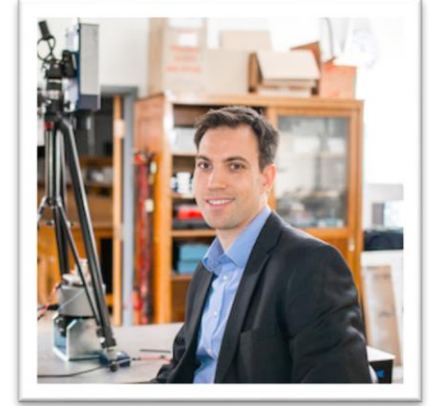


NSF Grant Awarded in Cybersecurity
