Suggestion box questions,

I write today with an issue that Dr. Barry Stein, as the Building Coordinator for Matthews-Daniel, suggests be brought to the attention of Faculty Senate.

Matthews-Daniel Hall faculty must all replace exterior keys due to an incident in which exterior Master Keys were lost by a non-Matthews-Daniel Hall employee. Dr. Stein, as Building Coordinator, and I have been told that the current interpretation of Policy 561 prevents adjuncts from being issued exterior door keys. I feel this policy is being applied unevenly as explained below.

I would like Faculty Senate to inquire:

- How Facilities expects adjuncts to enter the building and work without keys during non-regular hours (perhaps the weekend)?
- Are adjuncts in other buildings besides Matthews-Daniel no longer permitted exterior keys due to the current interpretation? Are keys being recalled if adjuncts already have them?
- Is Policy 561: https://tntech.policytech.com/dotNet/documents/?docid=621&public=true being implemented such that each building, each semester, is requiring keys of adjuncts to be recalled at the end of the semester, and then reassigned upon re-employment?
- Policy 561 does not address swipe keys. Are Adjuncts in swipe key buildings free to enter and leave after their contracts expire? After regular hours?
