THE NICHOLS FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP

The Nichols Freshman Scholarship will be awarded to one student who is a BFA major at Tennessee Technological University during the **2022-2023** academic year. This student will be awarded \$1000.00, to be applied to the fall 2022 semester. **This scholarship is for entering freshman only and is not renewable beyond the freshman year. *Students must first apply for the Nichols Freshman Scholarship on-line by December 15, 2021.** Apply at www.tntech.edu/scholarships/

To be considered for this scholarship, a student must meet the following criteria:

- 1) The student is admitted at Tennessee Technological University with a BFA major in the School of Art, Craft & Design.
- 2) The student must be an entering freshman in good standing in accordance with current institutional policies, as stated in the "Undergraduate Catalog," and must enroll in and complete 12 credit hours or more per semester.

The applicant must then submit the following materials for review by February 1, 2022, in addition to the ScholarWeb application due by December 15, 2021.

- 1) Five high resolution images of the applicant's work. Images must be JPEG files, with the title extension ".jpg" only. Do not put the images in a PowerPoint file, an iPhoto library, or any other presentation or archive format. Save each JPEG image with your name and an image number. (For example: JaneDoe #1. jpg). Images must be 300 dpi and sized at the pixel dimension of at least 1920 on the longest side.
- 2) An information sheet that lists each corresponding image #, title of piece, medium, dimensions, and date work was completed. Please type your name at the top of the page.
- 3) A single summary written statement that addresses your ideas, goals and intentions behind the work along with your college career goals while attending Tennessee Tech University. The statement must be 150-500 words, typed and double-spaced. The attached site can provide assistance: <http://www.gyst-ink.com/artist-statement-guidelines/>
- 4) Submit all materials via email to jdjohnson@tntech.edu , please include the applicant's name and "Nichols Freshman Scholarship Application" in the subject line of email.
