Prospective Instructors for Summer Workshops

Application Requirements and Instructor Qualifications

The application details all information that will be needed from you. Successful applications are written thoughtfully, with complete and concise responses to all questions. In addition to the proposed workshop descriptions, applicants' portfolios, prior teaching experience, and professional recommendations are reviewed.

Timeline

We accept proposals all year and keep applications on-file indefinitely. Because we continue to review applications, applicants will not be notified of declination.

August 17, 2026: Proposals due for Summer 2027

October 1, 2026: Acceptance notifications sent

September 30, 2026: Deadline for instructors to submit marketing and materials information

December 1, 2026: Workshops registration opens

March 2027: Instructor Orientations via Zoom

Preparation

Invited instructors must provide images, written workshop descriptions, and materials lists by the September 30 deadline. Images should be high quality and depict original works that are relevant to the workshop topic.

Workshops that do not meet minimum enrollment requirements within 30 days prior to their start date may be cancelled.

Compensation

Instructors are compensated for their time teaching and engaging with participants in workshops. The Craft Center also provides housing, meals, and a travel stipend.
