- Mid-range (cone 5-7) stoneware clay. Clay will be available for purchase from our clay studio for \$20-\$25 per 25 lb. bag (uncertainty about cost is an issue because of supply chain issues)
- Basic throwing and trimming tools with them. (wire tool, needle tool, sponges, soft throwing ribs, trimming tools). Kemper kits containing these tools are available in our Gallery store for \$18 or from Dick Blick <https://www.dickblick.com/products/kemper-pottery-tool-kit/>
- One or more metal ribs – available from the Ceramic Shop <https://www.theceramicshop.com/store/category/11/203/Ribs/Metal/>
- A good x-acto knife or similar knife – available at WalMart or any Hobby Store or Amazon
