A studio fee of \$50 is payable to the Craft Center for Clay and other consumable materials.

- 1 small water buckets (about 1 gallon capacity)
- A basic pottery kit containing a needle tool, small sponge, wire tool, wooden knife, a variety of ribs (metal, wooden, and/or flexible rubber/polymer ribs), and a few different sized trimming loop tools. Available for purchase from our Gallery Store for \$18.
- A towel (a old hand towel is fine)
- An apron
- A sketchbook
- Pens or pencils for sketching and taking notes
- Calipers
- Sharp clay knife (a exacto knife also works)
- A few smaller paint brushes (affordable brushes designed for watercolor or acrylic paint work well)

***If you are a beginner, buying the basics to save money is fine, but below are my favorite brands/models of tools if you plan to work with clay for a while and want the "good stuff"

- Audry's favorite basic tool kit is made by Kemper – available in the Craft Center's Gallery Store for \$18
- Audry's favorite trimming tools are: Kemper PT510 and the Kemper R1 Ribbon tool
- Audry's favorite ribs are: Mudtools Shape 1 yellow, Mudtools Shape 3 yellow, Mudtools Shape 0 red, the Mudtools Hax rib, and the Kemper S1 metal rib
- Audry's favorite sharp clay knife: Dolan DPT220 Knife
- Audry's favorite calipers: Griffin Lid Master
