Hands-on Soda Firing and Porcelain Cups! Cups! Cups! with Matthew Long

June 5-10, 2022

We will be firing the soda kiln, so you should bring:

- 10-12 bisque fired pots from home. These pots must be cone 10 clay!! If you're not sure, leave it at home!
- The best scenario is that you bring cups, small bowls, small jars etc.
- There should be nothing over 12" tall or more than 8" wide, **if it is bigger than these dimensions it will not get fired.**
- **NO PLATES!!**
- Work that is made during the workshop will be bisque fired only, or can be taken home green.
- Standard 257 clay – 50-75 lbs. You will be making work for 3-4 days.

We will concentrate on several topics:

- Throwing skills, understanding form, all aspects of what makes a cup work both aesthetically and functionally.
- We will be making work almost every day, along with demonstration and discussion on a daily basis.

Please bring with you:

- Tools that you make work with at your studio
- Some wide brushes, from 2"-6" wide
- You may purchase the recommended 100 lbs of Standard 257 from our clay studio at \$25 per 25 lb. bag
