If you have your own tools, feel free to bring them. You will have a selection of tools that you may use. We will also have clear rod and tube available for your use as well as a selection of color. If you have specifics that you like to work with, feel free to bring that.

- A torch to work w/ borosilicate glass ran w/propane.
- 2 pairs of long stainless steel tweezers (one pair w/ smooth interior and one with texture, if possible),
- small pointed tweezers(stainless steel forceps),
- 6"x6" graphite plate,
- small Diamond shears,
- small straight shears,
- graphite octagonal reamers for ring making,
- metal ring mandrel,
- marble molds,
- striker or lighter
- small brass paddle,
- carbide scoring knife,
- butter knife,
- sharp knife,
- tungsten,
- flat crimps (small and large),
- any other crimps available for the class to use and share.

A studio fee of \$75 is payable to the Craft Center for consumable supplies.
