- Several pieces of 24 ga copper. Squares or circles , multiples for each student.

- Brushes - round size 0, round size 2/0 and round size 3/0 - <https://www.dickblick.com/products/blick-master-bristle-brushes/> (scroll almost to the bottom of the page to find round brushes in the sizes required)
- Speedball Fine point dip pen nib size 100 and holder - <https://www.dickblick.com/products/speedball-calligraphy-project-set/?fromSearch=%2Fsearch%2F%3Fq%3Dpen%2520nib%2520size%2520100>
- metal painting pallet knife for mixing china paints: approximatly 1/2" x 1 7/8"
- small spatula - <https://www.dickblick.com/products/lineco-micro-spatula/>
- 2 cheap white ceramic tiles approximatly 4"x4" – available at Lowe’s or Home Depot in the tile department
- Old magazines (to work over)
- Any plastic lidded container to keep the paints from drying out – smallll deli containers work well
- 2 plastic cups
- 1 roll of Saral red transfer paper - <https://www.dickblick.com/items/saral-wax-free-transfer-paper-red/>
- Particulate masks - https://www.amazon.com/3M-8511PB1-Particulate-Respirator-10-Pack/dp/B0002YKBV2/ref=sr_1_10?crd=2R1DFDF5REVHV&keywords=particulate+mask&qid=1648758134&sprefix=particulate+mask%2Caps%2C70&sr=8-10 (this is one that may work for you. You can also find these at your local hardware store or WalMart type store in the paint department or sand paper area)
- Green IR safety glasses – we have these available for your use in the metals studio
- clear safety glasses – any safety glasses that wrap around to protect your eyes from metal and glass particulate
- Optical Visors (optional) – we have a few available for your use in the metals studio
- 6/o saw blades - <https://contenti.com/herkules-jeweler-s-saw-blades> (you can also find these at Rio Grande)
- jewelers saw – you may bring your own or borrow one from the metals studio
- files – again, you may bring your own or borrow some from the metals studio

- sandpaper 100 grit preferably made into a sanding stick – please bring 100 grit sandpaper – one or two sheets – available at any hardware store – wet/dry is the best sandpaper for this application – usually it is black)

Materials fee of \$20 is payable to instructor and includes 1 painting enamel kit - red, orange, yellow, green, blue, black and pen oil.
