Materials use will depend a lot on the designs of your rings. If you have it already I would bring a variety of different size silver wire and sheet. I will also bring silver wire and sheet in a variety of different gauges that can be purchased from me. You can also bring: Any stones you may have any small found objects: cool antique buttons or coins, rust metal objects, bottle caps, anything else that may look good on a ring.

Tool list: These are some recommended tools **to bring if you own them.**

#### Highly recommended

- Saw frame and blades
- Files - half round and needle
- Safety glasses

- Designing materials - pencil, paper, templates, etc
- Pliers and snips
- Ring clamp

Bring them if you got them (don't go out and buy them; Timothy and the studio will have for you to use):

- Scribe
- Burnisher

- Mini Square
- Pen vise
- Reading glasses or optivisors
- Dividers
- Any flex shaft attachment you see fit
- Ring mandrel
- Calipers
- Soldering pick
- Masking tape
- Any other of your favorite hand tools that you use on a regular basis

Materials fee: Timothy will bring some materials that can be purchased, including:

- silver sheet – variety of sizes
- wire – variety of sizes
- tubing - variety of sizes
- some stones for setting

Cost will depend on your designs but typically students might spend between \$20. - \$30
