INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION AND FEE PAYMENT

- 1. From the TTU Bands Marketplace Store, click on **Registration and Payment** for the TTU Festival of Winds and Percussion. Enter the **quantity of students** you are paying for. Click **add to cart**.
- 2. Enter your payment information (web-check or credit card). You will then be asked for registration information. This information must be complete for your student to be registered. (For band directors: Entering three students at a time and adding to the cart will prevent the system from timing out.
