- 4. Give the approved form to the recording engineer for your performance.

Terms:

- 1. Video services requests must be approved by Dr. Hansen. Recording engineers cannot take payment or informal requests. Please be sure to leave adequate time to receive a receipt and approval.
- 2. Video streaming does not guarantee the quality of viewing on client computers. Viewer experiences depend heavily on the client computer hardware, software, and internet connection. Refunds will be given only if the recording engineer verifies a failure to stream the program.
- 3. Recorded video will not be stored by the department. If requesting video recording, users will receive a USB flash drive containing a 1080p30 H.264 Quicktime movie. This flash drive is property of the department, and must be returned to Dr. Hansen's mailbox within four days. Failure to do so will result in an account hold. Performances typically result in a 3-5GB file.
