- The ***Institutional Assessment*** (IE) tab provides materials that support Course Evaluations and Assessment Reports designed to improve student learning, provide student feedback, suggestions for faculty improvement, and guidance to encourage data-led programmatic changes.
- The ***Institutional Research*** (IR) tab contains links to public-facing dashboards which contain current and trend data on student enrollment, retention, graduation, and faculty profiles. Additionally, static reports and specialized reports including Common Dataset, CUPA-HR, Delaware Study, Student Migration can also be found in this section.
- The ***Institutional Effectiveness*** (IE) tab contains resources that support the university's IE process for academic and non-academic units including timelines, training materials, and videos. The Academic IE Reports tab contains links to all College/Program-level IE reports.
- The ***Dashboards*** tab provides a direct link to the public-facing dashboards with institutional data and the fall daily enrollment dashboard.
- The ***Resources*** tab contains a link to the Data Request Form where constituents can request custom data/analysis that is not already provided by IARE.
- The ***Staff*** tab provides contact information for all IARE staff.

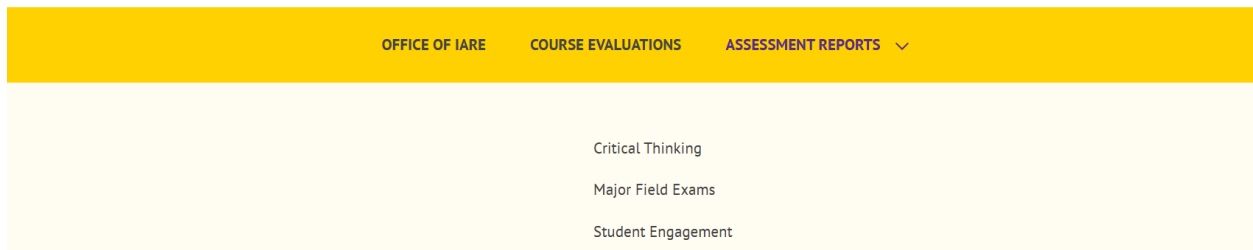

The **Institutional Assessment** (IA) process at Tennessee Tech provides guidance to improve student learning, provide feedback for faculty improvement, and present valid reliable data to impact program changes. The Assessments are often implemented in conjunction with THEC Quality Assurance Funding requirements, and SACSCOC accreditation standards.

The **Institutional Assessment** (IA) tab provides materials that support Course Evaluations and Assessment Reports to improve student learning, provide means to collect student feedback, suggestions for faculty improvement, and guidance to encourage data-led programmatic changes.

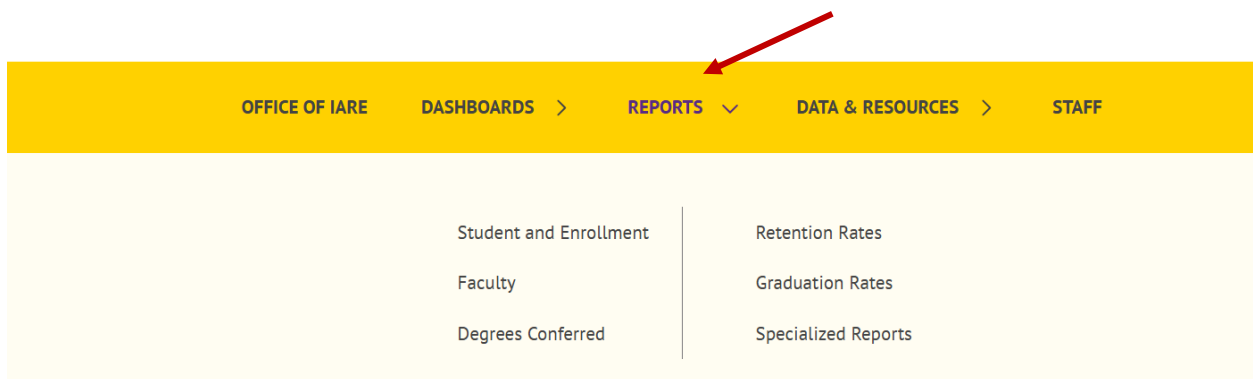
- The Course Evaluations tab contains resources related to the IDEA course evaluation tools including an overview of the institutional process and training materials including: survey templates, course objectives and training materials for faculty/chairpersons
- The Assessment Reports tab includes materials from the California Critical Thinking Skills Test, National Survey of Student Engagement surveys, Course Evaluations and Major Field Exams. The CCTST reports are disaggregated by College and Major. Student Engagement – contains reports for the National Survey of Student Engagement documenting student perceptions of their time at the institutions over the last five administrations.

Institutional Assessment, Research, and Effectiveness



Institutional Research (IR) provides information and analyses to support the University planning, evaluation, and management process. It provides analytical support regarding a broad array of subjects and is involved in ongoing data collection, analysis, and dissemination of information.

Institutional Research



- The ***Institutional Research*** tab contains links to Quick Facts, Dashboards and specialized reports of student enrollment, retention, degrees conferred, and faculty profiles.
 - The Reports tab contains links to public-facing data on Student Enrollment, Faculty Profile, Degrees Conferred, Retention, Graduation and Specialized Reports (Common Dataset, CUPA-HR, Delaware Study, Student Migration by College/Major), and links to more detailed reports for institutional staff/faculty.
 - The Data & Resources tab contains links to prior reports on Student Enrollment, Faculty Profile, Degrees Conferred, Retention, Graduation and Specialized Reports, and a link to the Data Request form. Access to the Tech IARE Reports Sharepoint will be required to view prior reports.

Institutional Effectiveness (IE) supports and facilitates planning and assessment at the departmental level. Campus Labs is used as a repository for student learning and program outcomes, assessment results, and modifications aimed at continuous improvement.
