# Tennessee Tech Student Profile and Enrollment Trends Quality Assurance Funding (QAF) Student Equity Enrollment Students of Color, Fall 2023

The Quality Assurance Funding Student Equity Enrollment report provides enrollment and demographic data for the QAF's selected student group. For 2020-2025, the current group of students selected are Students of Color. THEC defines Students of Color as Alaskan Native, American Indian, Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, and two or more races. This report includes:

- Enrollment and demographic summary data for the current semester; and
- Five-year demographic and enrollment trend data at the institution level.

#### Data Notes:

- 1. All data conforms to TTU internal reporting standards and may differ slightly from official reports provided to external constituents such as the Tennessee Higher Education Commission (THEC). Differences in reporting date can also cause minor discrepancies
- 2. Unless otherwise noted, all data represents 14th Day census counts for the specified time period.
- 3. Program names, department names, and department affiliations are as of the most recent Fall term. Programs that were different in previous years are mapped to the current definition.
- 4. "Independent Programs" has been relabeled "Non-Degree Seeking" to better reflect the students within this group.
- 5. As defined by THEC, "Students of Color" includes students who self-identify as Alaskan Native/American Indian, Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, or two or more races.
- 6. Pell-Eligibility and First-Generation Status are collected from the FAFSA. Financial Aid data is only provided for Undergraduate students.
