

# Tennessee Tech Student Profile and Enrollment Trends - University Report

The Student Profiles and Enrollment Trends report is produced every Fall and Spring semester and reports the University's summarized and disaggregated enrollment. This comprehensive report includes:

- Enrollment and demographic summary data for the current semester;
- Five-year demographic and enrollment trend data at the college level; and
- Ten-year enrollment trend data by level, program and concentration for each college.

## *Data Notes:*

1. All data conforms to TTU internal reporting standards and may differ slightly from official reports provided to external constituents such as the Tennessee Higher Education Commission (THEC). Differences in reporting date can also cause minor discrepancies.
2. Unless otherwise noted, all data represents 14<sup>th</sup> Day census counts for the specified time period.
3. Program names, department names, and department affiliations are as of the most recent Fall term. Programs that were different in previous years are mapped to the current definition.
4. “Independent Programs” has been relabeled “Non-Degree Seeking” to better reflect the students within this group.
5. As defined by THEC, “Students of Color” includes students who self-identify as Alaskan Native/American Indian, Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, or two-or more races. A detailed distribution by Race/Ethnicity is available by clicking on the Race/Ethnicity subheading within a table.
6. For Race/Ethnicity, the category “Other” includes Asian and Race/Ethnicity Unknown.
7. Pell-Eligibility and First-Generation Status are collected from the FAFSA. Financial Aid data is only provided for Undergraduate students.


