#### **Tennessee Tech Annual Degrees Conferred Report**

The *Annual Degrees Conferred* report provides information about degrees awarded by the institution. Awards are summarized at the college and program level.

#### Data Notes:

- 1. All data conforms to TTU internal reporting standards and may differ slightly from official reports provided to external constituents such as the Tennessee Higher Education Commission. Differences in reporting date can also cause minor discrepancies.
- 2. Program names, department names, and department affiliations are as of the most recent Fall term. Programs that were different in previous years are mapped to the current definition.
- 3. As defined by THEC, "Students of Color" include students who self-identify as Alaskan Native/American Indian, Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, or two or more races.
- 4. For Race/Ethnicity, the category "Other" includes Asian and Race/Ethnicity Unknown.
- 5. Pell-Eligibility and First-Generation Status are pulled from the FAFSA. Students are flagged as Pell-Eligible or First-Generation if they were eligible to receive the Pell grant or be considered First-Generation at any time during their college career. Financial Aid data is only provided for Undergraduate students.
- 6. Students may receive more than one degree in a given time frame. All degrees will display, but each student is only counted once under demographics.
- 7. An academic year is defined as Summer, Fall and Spring semesters for the specified time period. For example, the academic year 2020-21 includes Summer 2020, Fall 2020, and Spring 2021.
