Enrollment in Minors Fall 2021

The annual *Enrollment in Minors* report provides information about students that have declared any minor at the institution during the most recent Fall semester. This report shows which minors students are enrolled in and the relationship between a student's primary major college and the student's minor college.

Data Notes:

1. All data conforms to TTU internal reporting standards and may differ slightly from official reports provided to external constituents such as the Tennessee Higher Education Commission. Differences in reporting date can also cause minor discrepancies.
2. Unless otherwise noted, all data represents 14th Day census counts for the Fall semester.
3. Program names, department names, and department affiliations are as of the most recent Fall term. Programs that were different in previous years are mapped to the current definition.
4. Minors have been grouped into colleges based on the last Course Catalog, from each College's website, or by our office's best judgement. The 'Honors' and 'Leadership & Military Science' minors have been listed under an 'Other' category.
5. Students may declare more than one minor. If a student has more than one minor, they show up once per each minor.
