



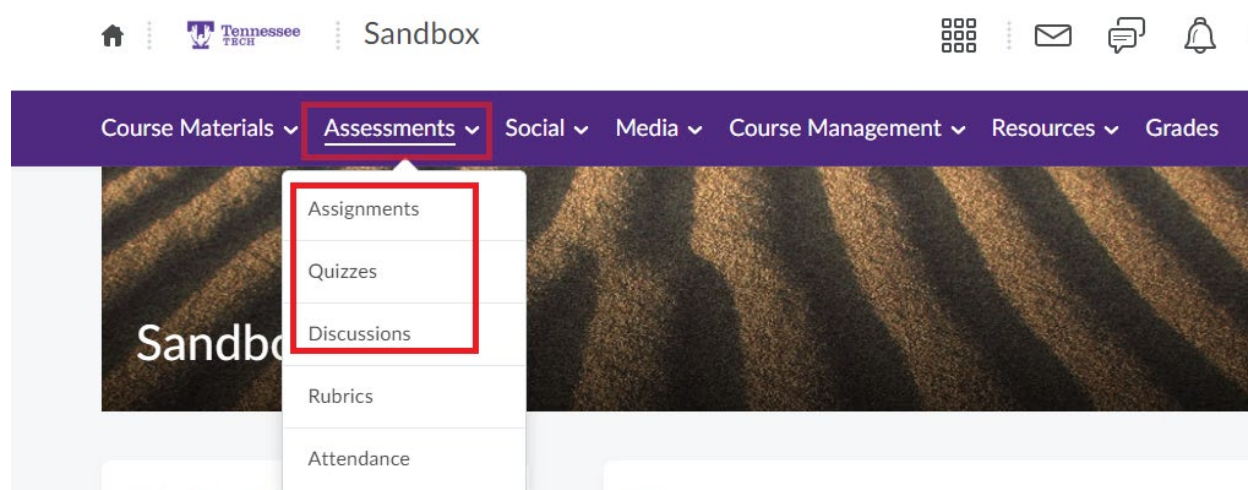
iLearn: Locate Assignments, Quizzes, Discussions, and Other Course Materials

Assignments and supplemental materials are provided by your instructor either in the **Assignments** section of iLearn, or in the **Content** area.

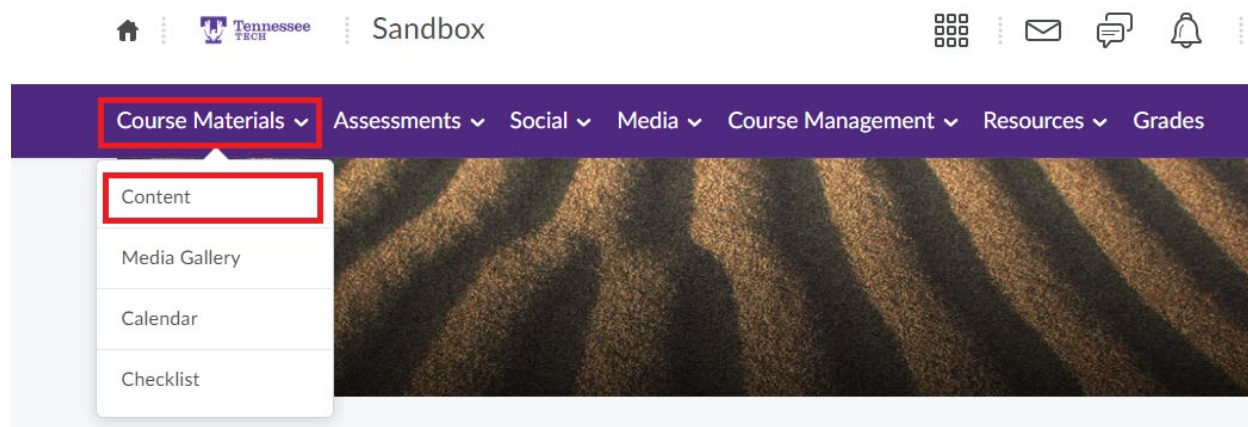
To access the **Assignments**, **Quizzes**, or the **Discussion** section:

- Select the dropdown menu for Assessments in the Nav bar

- Select Content from the menu
